Child Physical Abuse: A Medical Perspective.

Dr. Joyce Gilbert, medical director of the Providence Sexual Assault Clinic and Child Maltreatment Center in Lacey provided a training designed to educate non-medical professionals on the treatment of child physical abuse. Dr Gilbert has provided medical services to children who are victims of sexual or physical abuse for nearly 40 years and actively participates in Multidisciplinary Teams (MDTs) in Thurston, Lewis, Pacific County, and Grays Harbor Counties. In her training, Dr. Gilbert will focus on educating attendees on signs/symptoms of physical abuse, the function of medical evaluations for children, and education about injuries most often see in children who have been physically abused.
