

Proposed Rule	Comment Due Date	Brief Description of Proposal
CrR 3.1	Sept. 30, 2021	Creates a court rule right to counsel, without regard to a defendant's indigency, for any person (i) serving a sentence for a conviction based on a statute determined to be void, invalid, or unconstitutional, or (ii) serving a sentence that was calculated under RCW 9.94A.525 using a prior conviction based on a statute determined to be void, invalid, or unconstitutional.
CrR 7.8	Sept. 30, 2021	Adds language to CrR 7.8(c)(2) that would restrict a trial court's ability to transfer a collateral attack that includes a <i>Blake</i> claim to the court of appeals for consideration as a personal restraint petition.
New GR 40 (IDRT)	Sep. 28, 2021	Creates a new statewide informal domestic relations trial option.
CrR 3.4	Sept. 30, 2021	Expands remote hearings in criminal cases. The suggested amendments address issues such as standards for audio and video quality, the use of electronic signatures, access to interpreters, and visibility of the public during a remote proceeding. The same safeguards suggested in subsection (e) are suggested for Remote Proceedings under chapter 10.77 RCW in subsection (f).
New GR 40	Dec. 29, 2021	Codifies a virtual method for voir dire for "all cases," civil and criminal.
CR 39	Dec. 29, 2021	Creates standard procedures for remote civil jury trials.
