Description:

This Training of Trainers (ToT) will prepare people to deliver the evidence-based *Responding to Sexual Exploitation and Trafficking of Youth* foundational training in a flexible format.

Responding to Sexual Exploitation and Trafficking of Youth prepares service providers and first responders to identify, engage, and support sexually exploited youth. Topics include laws and definitions, language, the landscape of exploitation, identification, and engagement.

The ToT is three online sessions, 4 hours each. Participants must attend all three sessions, as well as complete a 1-hour online training, prior to starting the training on August 9th, 2022. Space is limited.

Prerequisites:
