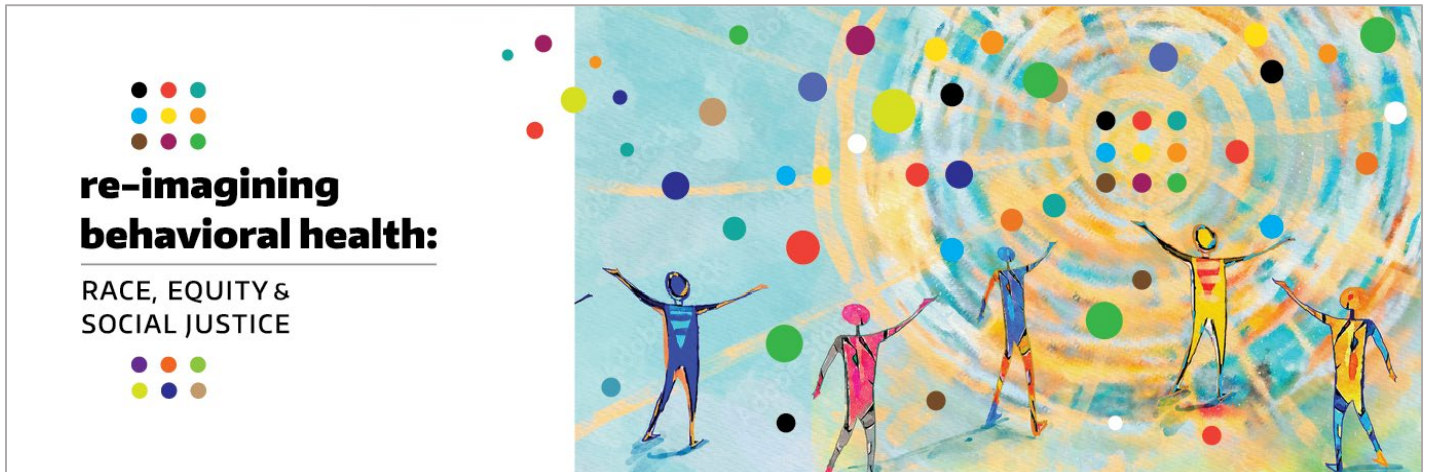


3rd Annual Conference Registration is Now Open!
